The below **Senior Exit College Counseling Checklist** was sent to the seniors on May 13. Please check in with your child to ensure that the below tasks are complete!

Senior Exit College Counseling Checklist

- **Update SCOIR:** To ensure your final transcript is sent to your final choice school, please mark it as “Enrolling.”
- Please also **update any admission results that are currently listed as “pending”** with the appropriate outcomes.
- **Deposit to Final College Choice:** Ensure that you have submitted your tuition and/or housing deposit(s) to your final choice of college or university.
- **Send Official Score Reports:** If you applied with testing OR if your college requires SAT or ACT scores to confirm enrollment, you must submit them to finalize your spot in their class.
- **Complete Financial Aid Process:** Complete all required financial aid forms and processes (if applicable).
- **Maintain Good Academic Standing:** Be in good academic standing and on track to meet graduation requirements.
- **Confirm Housing Arrangements:** Contact your college or university to verify that you have completed all necessary housing forms, especially if you plan to reside on campus during your first year.
- **Placement Tests:** Ensure that you have taken all required placement tests and are familiar with your institution’s procedures for completing them.
- **College Course Registration:** Be mindful of college/university-specific requirements surrounding course registration; often enough there are steps to take beforehand to ensure you can register for classes.
- **Waitlist Admission:** If you are admitted from a waitlist after June 1 and choose to attend, you must contact the college counseling office to have your materials forwarded.
